Senior on Spotlight



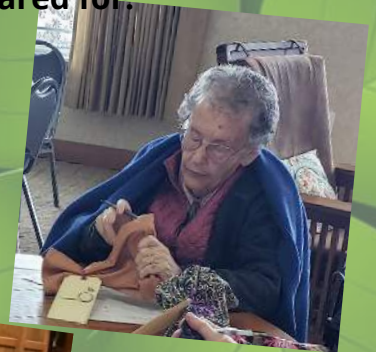
